

Condo 1 - Suggestions for Plantings (street side) Common Areas

Osmanthus Goshiki (False Holly)

Evergreen, partial to full sun. Grows 3 – 6 ft.

Threadleaf False Cypress

Evergreen, gold color. Mophead form. Partial to full sun. Very slow growing. Can reach 5 – 6 ft.

Elf Dwarf Mountain Laurel

Evergreen. Partial to full sun. Clusters of white flowers. Grows 3 – 4 ft.

Pieris Japonica (also known as Lily of the Valley shrub because of the white pendant flowers)

Evergreen. Some varieties can have variegated leaves. Shade to partial sun. Slow growing but can reach 6 – 10 ft.

Boxwood (best known type is English Boxwood)

Evergreen, tolerant of sun exposure and soil. Slow growing small leaved plant. Can be clipped or sheared)

Evergreen. Partial shade. Drooping clusters of flowers similar to those of Pieris Japonica.

Dwarf Fothergilla

Deciduous shrub with fragrant cream to white flowers. Brilliant fall foliage. Partial to full sun. Grows to 2- 3 ft.

Crepe Myrtle dwarf

There are many crepe myrtles in Cross Keys but this variety is a dwarf and appropriate for the front planting areas. Deciduous plant with brilliant flowers. Full sun. reaches 3 – 5 ft.

Evergreen. Grows best in partial shade. Native shrub. Grows to 4 to 6 ft.
